1. What is DIT?

Dar es Salaam Institute of Technology (DIT) is a higher education institution in Tanzania, focused on technical training, engineering, ICT, and industrialization.

2. What academic programmes does DIT offer?

DIT offers a wide range of programmes:

- **Ordinary Diplomas** (NTA Levels 4–6) in engineering, IT, biotechnology, laboratory science, etc.

3. What are the admission requirements for DIT?

Requirements vary by programme:

- **Ordinary Diploma (NTA 4–6):** CSEE with at least four passes including Physics/Engineering Science, Mathematics, and Chemistry.
- **Bachelor (3-year):** Ordinary Diploma (NTA 6) with minimum GPA.
- **Bachelor (4-year):** ACSEE with specific subject combinations and minimum points.
- **Master's programmes:** Relevant Bachelor's degree with required GPA or experience.
